Erik Hite was a police officer who gave his life in the line of dangerous duty in 2008. His widow, Nohemy Hite, has established in his memory the Erik Hite Foundation. The foundation is a non-profit organization that provides a child care center and family programs for the children of law enforcement and emergency services personnel. The center serves personnel from agencies such as the Tucson Police Department, Pima County Sheriff's Department, US Border Patrol, US Immigration and Customs, and the fire department. 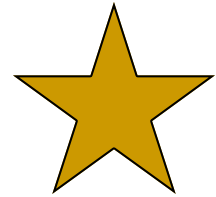
